

CITY OF SACRAMENTO – LOCAL ART INVESTMENTS

- Arts and Cultural Facilities Grants: Providing financial assistance to local arts organizations' efforts to renovate, construct or acquire arts and cultural facilities. **(Total: \$371,051)** ([Website](#))
- Arts Education Individual Artists Grants: Grants to individual artists to do work in the schools and the community. **(Total: \$6,480)**
- B Street Theatre: City approved **\$2.5 million** to be used as the final funding for the completion of a new home for B-Street Theater in downtown Sacramento. ([Article](#))
- City of Festivals Special Event Support Grant Program: CCS program for nonprofit organizations only, includes grants given to art organizations. ([Website](#))
- Creative Aging: SMAC provides individual artist grants for education.
- Cultural Arts Awards: City allocation helped fund 55 organizations this year. **(Total: \$135,000)** ([Website](#))
- Cultural Equity Grants: Grants to be made available this year to small arts organizations serving historically underserved communities such as African-American, Asian, Disabled, Latino, L/G/B/T, Native American, Pacific Islander, and Women. **(Total: \$500,000)** ([Article](#))
- Del Paso Words on Walls: 10 artists for temporary public art on Del Paso Boulevard. ([Website](#))
- Entertainment and Sports Center (ESC): **\$1.5 million** to commission art from local and regional artists to be integrated throughout the ESC. ([Press release](#))
- Organizational development grants (scholarships provided by SMAC) to attend workshops at the Nonprofit Resource Center. **(Total: \$3,120)** ([Website](#))
- Public Art Program: Funded by two percent of the city's capital improvement program (CIP), which allows for the integration of art into a project. The completed projects range from portable works that are displayed throughout the city in the form of sculptures, installations, galleries, and integrated projects in city buildings and parks. **(Total: \$1.5 million since 2008)** ([Website](#))
- Public Business Improvement Districts (citywide): Funding for individual Sacramento artists to produce temporary art projects throughout the city. In the past two years, the City has supported commissioning **52 individual artists**. ([Article](#))
- Studios for the Performing Arts: City Council will consider on March 17 for approval. City's contribution is **\$5 million** towards a \$6.5 million renovation of the historic Fremont School to create a permanent home for several performing arts organizations and a visual arts education program through the school district. ([Article](#))
- Verge Arts Center: As part of the capital grant program - **\$50,000** was provided to the Verge as final funding for the purchase and redevelopment of a contemporary arts center and provides studio space for 38 individual Sacramento artists. ([Article](#))
