



IMT calls are responded to by DCR and the Sacramento Police Department Rapid IMPACT Team and include all call types. As of November 2024, compliance data are reported by DCR/IMT; numbers are based on a count of unique locations responded to within the 311 system. Compliance on critical infrastructure is inclusive of unlawful camping and illegal storage on critical infrastructure. Data on average number of shelter beds are reported between Monday and Friday of the reporting week.
